This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data; and submit acceptable responses required for reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 4.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 1448-374."

b. Revise the Environmental Hazards statement according to PR Notice 93-10 (published July 29, 1993): "This product is toxic to fish and aquatic organisms. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product to sewer systems without previously notifying the local sewage treatment plant authority. For guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA."

c. In the Statement of Practical Treatment, revise the sentence "On contact with eyes" to: "If In Eyes:". And, the beginning parts of these instructions: "If In Eyes", "If Spilled on Person", "If Swallowed" and "If Inhaled"; should be capitalized or printed in larger or bolder type from the remaining text.

d. In the Directions For Use section, insert the following statements:

- "For formulation into end-use products intended as a bactericide, fungicide in pulp and paper mill systems, secondary oil recovery injection water systems or as a preservative in waterbased coatings."

- "Reformulators and repackagers of this product must obtain their own registration from the Environmental Protection Agency."

3. The active ingredient used in this product formulation is currently undergoing the process of reregistration. Therefore, if additional requirements are imposed on this chemical under the reregistration process this product will also be required to comply with the Reregistration Eligibility Document (RED).

4. Submit one copy of your final printed labeling which incorporates the comments listed above before releasing the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: On contact with eyes, wash eyes with water for 15 minutes. Call physician. If spilled on person, remove clothing at once and wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing before reusing. Should blistering occur, treat as thermal burn, apply analgesic.

If swallowed, drink promptly large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

If inhaled, remove person to fresh air. If not breathing give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth. Call a physician.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not store near feed or food products. Do not mix with other chemicals.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Pesticide wastes are acutely hazardous. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of Federal Law.
