Precautionary Statements

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

FIRST AID	
if in Eyes	- Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes Remove contact tenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
If on Skin, Clothes	- Take off contaminated ciothing Rinse skin immediately with plonty of water for 15-20 minutes Call a poison control center for treatment advice.
If Ingested	- Call poison control centor or doctor immediately for treatment advice Have person sip a glass of water, if able to swallow Do not induce vomitting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
if Inhaled	- Move person to fresh air. - If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth if possible. - Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage

DANGER. Corrosive, causes irreversible eye damage and skin burns. May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin or inhaled. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Wear goggles or face shield, a mask or pesticide respirator jointly approved by MSHA and OSHA, protective clothing and shoes, and rubber gloves. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Prolonged or frequently repeated skin contact may cause allergic reactions in some individuals.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This posticide is toxic to fish. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge.
