

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin burns. May cause allergic skin reaction. Harmful if inhaled. Avoid breathing mist. Harmful if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin, on clothing. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Drink promptly a large quantity of egg whites, gelatin solution, or, if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. If Inhaled: Remove immediately to fresh air. If not breathing, apply artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Call a physician. If on Skin: Wash thoroughly with soap and water. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before re-use.

If in Eyes: Flush with plenty of water for 15 minutes. Call a physician. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS: This chemical is toxic to terrestrial and aquatic plants, fish and aquatic invertebrates.
