

SAPSTAIN AND MOLD CONTROL: BUSAN 1223 is used to control sapstain and mold on freshly cut hardwood and softwood lumber, logs, poles, posts and timbers. It is applied by dipping the wood until complete surface wetting is accomplished. Use 0.5 to 2.0 gallons of BUSAN 1223/100 gallons water (5 to 18 lbs of BUSAN 1223/100 gallons water) and agitate vigorously until BUSAN 1223 is thoroughly dispersed. Rates to be used will vary according to temperature, humidity, wood moisture, storage conditions, etc. Under conditions suitable for aggressive mold growth, the high rate mentioned above should be used. Treatment should be made as quickly as possible after lumber is cut and always within 24 hours after cutting.

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
