1. Revise you precautionary labeling statements as follows:

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

#### WARNING

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear safety glasses. Harmful if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing dust. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse.

2. Change "STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT" to "FIRST AID" and modify as follows:

#### FIRST AID

IF IN EYES: Hold eyelids open and flush with a steady gentle stream of water for 15 minutes. Get medical attention.

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention.

3. Revised the second sentence of your "Environmental Hazards" statement to read:

Do not apply directly to water.

- 4. Move the statement, "Do not apply on open cuts or sores." to the **end** of your use directions.
- 5. Revise your "Storage and Disposal" Statement as follows:

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store only in original container, in a dry

place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. [If bottle, can, or jar, add "Rinse

thoroughly."] Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.
