PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DIRECTIONS: To Kill Fleas and Lice, pour one tablespoon of HILO[®] Dip Concentrated Fleas into a gallon of water. To Kill Ticks, make solution 4 times as strong. Saturate dog's coat thoroughly for several minutes and dry without rinsing. Repeat when necessary. To Kill Lice on long-haired dogs, bathe first with soap and water. Rinse out soap. Then use HILO[®] Dip Concentrated Fleas solution as a 4:1 dilution. **NOT FOR USE ON CATS.** Not for use on puppies less than 4 weeks old.
