This product is extremely toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marches, potholes).

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**IF SWALLOWED:** Call a physician or poison control center.

**IF IN EYES:** Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

**IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING:** Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water.

**DIAGNOSIS:** Ear mites normally cause a dry, dark, brown, waxy exudate with crusts in the ears of dogs and cats. The mites are easily observed by placing some of the ear exudate on a dark surface and watching for white speck walking away. DO NOT probe, swab, or injure the delicate tissue of the ear when removing exudate. Inflamed, watery, or blocked ear canals indicate a more serious condition which requires the services of a veterinarian.

**STORAGE & DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
