Your Submissions Dated June 19, 1990 and January 28, 1991**

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

The storage stability data submitted to support this pesticide indicate the presence of N-octyl bicycloheptene dicarboximide as an ingredient. This is not an ingredient in this pesticide. In the future, testing should be done with the actual formulation to be marketed. Report the actual concentration of active ingredient(s) at the beginning of the test, and, if dilutions are made, the dilution factor should be given.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use the product in a manner inconsistent with its labelling.

For control of ticks, fleas and lice dilute 4 ounces of concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin.

For control of ear mites, while dipping, lightly sponge inside of ears.

Do not rinse. Towel dry. Repeat as necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool dry place inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat and direct sunlight. Protect from freezing.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspapers and discard in trash.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with eyes. Do not contaminate food or feedstuffs with this concentrate or dip.
