GRANULAR DOG AND CAT REPELLENT**

Will repel dogs and cats for 1 week to 10 days under ordinary weather conditions. A training aid for your own pets.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To prevent your pet, or stray animals, from soiling flower beds, areas of lawn, trees, shrubbery or evergreens: Apply these granules by hand or with a fertilizer spreader to borders of flower beds; or to ground and grass around the base of shrubs, trees and evergreens; or to patches of lawn you wish to protect. Sprinkle enough to cover the treated area lightly (about 4 pounds per 1000 sq. ft., or 1-2 cups for 100 sq. ft.) Repeat applications until the undesirable animal habits are broken. Repeat applications after rains.

To protect garbage cans and rubbish containers from disturbance by dogs and cats, sprinkle the ground or floor about them liberally with granules. Repeat as necessary.

Stray animals are frequently attracted to areas where urine or feces have been deposited. First, remove any droppings then apply these granules. Do not apply these granules directly to foliage of shrubs or to ornamental, soft-bodied plants. Do not apply on or near food crops.

For most effective results this repellent product should be used in conjunction with training.

CAUTION:

Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Use gloves if applying by hand. Avoid contact with skin. Wash hands with soap and water after applying granules.

WARRANTY: Seller makes no warranty, expressed or implied, concerning the use of this product other than indicated on the label. Buyer assumes all risk of use and/or handling of this material when such use and/or handling is contrary to label instructions.
