- 1. The label statement appearing on the front panel of the label declaring "A Botanical Insecticide" is misleading and therefore is not appropriate under the provisions of 40 CFR part 156.10 (a) (5) (vii). Delete this phrase.
- 2. Delete the statement "Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard" from the STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT. This statement is not appropriate.
