**DOGS:** To kill fleas and lice, dilute dip at the rate of 1 ounce per gallon of water. To kill ticks, dilute dip at the rate of 2 ounces per gallon of water. For dogs under 6 months of age and for dogs under 5 pounds, use  $\frac{1}{2}$  the recommended dilution rate. Do not use on nursing puppies. Apply diluted mix directly to the pet as a rinse or sponge bath until pet's skin is wet. Avoid contact with eyes, nose or mouth of pet. If treatment of these areas is necessary, moisten fingers with diluted dip and rub in moist fingers around head and face.

**CATS:** To kill fleas, ticks and lice, dilute dip at the rate of 1 ounce per gallon of water. DO NOT USE ON YOUNG OR NURSING KITTENS. Apply diluted mix directly to the pet as a rinse or spongs bath until pet's skin is wet. Avoid contact with eyes, nose or mouth of pet. If treatment of these areas is necessary, moisten fingers with diluted dip and run in moist fingers around head and face.
