Petscription Lawn Spray  
EPA Registration No. 1452-29  
Your Application Dated December 7, 1991

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The term "home use" is vague and probably unenforceable in many states. Since there is a definition for "residential use - use of a pesticide directly on humans or pets; in, on, or around any structure, vehicle, article, surface or area associated with the household, including but not limited to areas such as non-agricultural outbuildings, non-commercial greenhouses, pleasure boats and recreational vehicles; or in or around any preschool or day care facility - we prefer the following statement:

"For Use On Residential Lawns and Around Residential Premises Only"

This statement should also avoid inadvertently coming under agricultural use rules since use would be limited to non-agricultural/non-commercial sites.

2. Changing "Compressed Air Sprayer" to "Hose-End Sprayer Jar" is acceptable.

**LAWN FLEA CONTROL:**

10-15 lbs. harboring in lawns use the concentrate in a hose and sprayer. Place required amount of concentrate in sprayer per (see chart below) and fill with water to the recommended level. Mix Well. Attach to sprayer and spray as recommended. For best results lawns should be mowed a day or two before spraying. Spray using a slow, even sweeping motion. Avoid areas to cover the entire lawn surface where the acts will normally frequent. Spray under ornaments and trees, but avoid soaking young or flowering plants. Repeat treatments may be necessary at 7 to 14 day intervals.  
 Keep pets and children out of the treated area until after the spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Dogs, cats, their kennel or bedding area should also be treated with a registered flea control product in conjunction with the application.

Amount of Product to Use Field Sprayer*	Amount of Water to Use	Area to be Treated
1 1/2 fluid ounces	3 gallons	500 sq. ft. (50' x 10')
2 2/3 fluid ounces	6 gallons	1,000 sq. ft. (50' x 20')
5 1/2 fluid ounces	12 gallons	2,000 sq. ft. (50' x 40')

\*NOTE: 1 fluid ounce = 2 Teaspoonsful = 6 Teaspoonsful

**FOR OUTDOOR PESTS:**

Mix concentrate in a hose and sprayer or watering can at the rate of 16 (sixteen) fluid ounces per one (1) gallon of water to control on contact cockroaches, pavement bugs, ants, crickets, scorpions, spiders, and ticks. Use at the rate of one (1) gallon (16 fluid ounces) per 1,000 square feet on outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patio, garages and other areas where these pests have been seen or are found. Do not spray in or near fish ponds or other bodies of water. Do not allow spray to contact ornamental plants or shrubs because of possible injury.
