On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby Registered/Reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act.

A copy of the labeling accepted in connection with this Registration/Reregistration is returned herewith.

Registration is in no way to be construed as an endorsement or approval of this product by this Agency. In order to protect health and the environment, the Administrator, at his discretion, may at any time suspend or cancel the registration of a pesticide in accordance with the Act. The acceptance of any name in connection with the registration of a product under this Act is not to be construed as giving the registrant a right to exclusive use of the name or its use if it has been covered by others.

1. The product name must be clearly legible and must be printed in a size which is easily readable.

2. Submit/attach to the registrant a copy of the label for the product that is of your own design and is in accordance with the requirements of the Act and the label for the product that is being registered.

3. Make the label changes listed below before you place the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 142-33."
- b. You must choose another name for your product other than "Pescription . . ." or there is a possibility of there being some confusion, since the name of the product is too similar to the word "Pescription."

4. Storage Stability--the formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage should be in warehouse conditions of temperature and humidity and stored in similar containers you will be using in the trade. Note: for the storage stability study, you cannot reference the concentrate you are using to formulate your product.

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4. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-7^o enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.
