PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing of dust and contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Wash hands with soap and warm water after handling and before eating or smoking. For eyes, flush with plenty of water. If irritation persists, get medical attention.

Do not contaminate food, water, or foodstuffs. Do not use in food serving areas while food is exposed. Food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered or thoroughly washed after treatment. Cover fish aquariums before use. Keep children and pets off treated carpet and upholstered furniture during treatment and until area is vacuumed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Induce vomiting by giving victim 1 or 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and warm water.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Give nothing by mouth to an unconscious person.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT
IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

DIRECTIONS: Shake well before using! Punch plastic seal. For use on carpets*, hold upside down and shake powder evenly across surface. Brush lightly with a broom to allow powder to penetrate carpet fibers. Wait 60 minutes, then vacuum. For severe problems or where ticks are known to be hiding, wait 2-3 hours before vacuuming. If powder adheres to spot, brush it out and vacuum immediately. Apply to dry surfaces only. Do not allow powder to become wet. For use on upholstery*, remove all loose cushions. Sprinkle along creases, in corners. Brush gently, wait 60 minutes, vacuum. Sprinkle along underside of furniture. Do not use on exposed fabric; may cause staining. Remove bag from vacuum cleaner. Wrap securely in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

*NOTE: Test on hidden surface of carpet or upholstery before using. If texture or color is affected, do not use.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry, locked storage area.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper before discarding in trash.
