2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

a. Revise the front panel to read as follows: Hilo Lawn Spray.

For use on residential lawns and around  
residential premises to kill fleas and  
ticks. Kills deer ticks . . . etc.

b. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 1452-49."

c. The term ACTIVE INGREDIENTS should be changed to singular "ACTIVE INGREDIENT," and the terms ACTIVE INGREDIENT and INERT INGREDIENTS should have the same type size.

- d. Under "Precautionary Statements" change the first sentence to read as follows:

. . . Harmful if swallowed, absorbed through skin or inhaled, causes moderate eye irritation . . . .

and also on the fourth line after the sentence "wash with soap and warm water after reuse" add the following phrase ". . . Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse."

- e. Under "Environmental Hazards" after the sentence "Do not apply directly to water," delete the following phrase:

. . . or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes and potholes).

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

#### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT  
IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

#### LAWN FLEA AND TICK CONTROL:

To kill fleas harboring in lawns use this concentrate in a hose-end sprayer. Place required amount of concentrate in sprayer jar (see chart below) and fill with water to the recommended level. Mix well. Attach to sprayer and spray as recommended. For best results lawn should be mowed a day or two before spraying. Spray using a slow, even sweeping motion, being sure to cover the entire lawn surface where the pets will normally frequent. Spray under ornamentals and trees, but avoid soaking young or flowering plants. Repeat treatments may be necessary at 7 to 14 day intervals. Kills on contact the Ixodes dammini tick (deer tick), which transmits Lyme disease. Also kills foraging fire ants upon direct contact. A registered fire ant mound treatment should also be used in conjunction with this product.

Keep pets and children out of the treated area until after the spray has dried. do not spray animals. Dogs, cats, their kennel or bedding area should also be treated with a registered flea control product in conjunction with this application.

### FOR OUTDOOR PESTS:

Mix concentrate in a compressed air sprayer or watering can at the rate of two (2) fluid ounces per one (1) gallon of water to control on contact cockroaches, palmetto bugs, ants, crickets, sowbugs, spiders and ticks. Use at the rate of one (1) gallon (diluted spray) per 1,000 square feet to outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patios, garages and other areas where these pests have been seen or are found. Do not spray in or near fish ponds or other bodies of water. Do not allow spray to contact ornamental plants or shrubs because of possible injury.

### RACK CARD:

#### DIRECTIONS FOR HOSE-END SPRAYER

The hose-end sprayer cap is calibrated to deliver the correct amount of lawn spray over 3,000 square feet of lawn. Use this hose-end sprayer cap ONLY with the accompanying bottle of lawn spray in accordance with bottle label directions.

to use hose-end sprayer cap:

1. Remove bottle cap (save for storage after use) and insert white tube into bottle.
2. Screw garden hose into back of spray cap.
3. Screw bottle into bottom of sprayer cap COUNTER-CLOCKWISE until tight.
4. Turn on water.
5. TO START FLOW OF INSECTICIDE place index finger over hole on right side of sprayer cap.
6. Spray evenly and completely over lawns and other infested areas giving special attention to areas frequented by pets.
7. TO STOP FLOW OF INSECTICIDE simply remove index finger from hole on right side of sprayer cap.
8. TO STORE REMAINING INSECTICIDE turn off water supply and remove bottle from hose-end sprayer cap by turning clockwise. Replace bottle cap and securely tighten. Rinse off sprayer cap. Follow bottle label storage and disposal instructions.
