2. Make the labeling change listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 1452-51."
- b. The claim "A Botanical Insecticide" is unacceptable since it indirectly applies safety of the product. The active ingredient Pyrethrins are derived from flowers. If you wish you may qualify the claim as follows, "Contains Pyrethrins which are derived from flowers" and place it in the general text (i.e. not highlighted on the front panel) or delete it altogether.
- c. Revise Precautionary Statements as follows:

"Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Harmful if inhaled. Causes eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove clothing ....."

- d. Revise the front panel statement as follows:

"May be applied as a direct spray to control fleas, ticks on pets and other crawling insect pests on premises."

- e. Change "states" to stages on back panel. Also the instruction beginning "Spray to lightly dampen . . ." should read "Spray to lightly dampen surfaces but do not allow runoff to occur."

3. Your Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) will not meet the label claim for the nominal concentration for the active ingredients. Refer to PR-Notice 91-2 and 40 CFR 158.175 for guidance and revise the CSF to reflect the nominal concentration of the active ingredients.

4. Submit five copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

**TO CONTROL FLEAS AND TICKS ON DOGS:**

Applied as a Spray:

Start spraying at the tail, moving the dispenser rapidly and making sure that the animal's entire body is treated, including the legs and underbody. Fluff the hair while spraying so that the spray will penetrate to the skin and thoroughly wet it. Do not spray into eyes or face. Avoid contact with genitalia.

Applied as a Dip:

Wet the dog with water before treatment. Sponge or pour on the dog until its fur and skin are thoroughly wet, making sure that the animal's entire body is treated, including the legs and underbody. Do not treat the dog's face. Avoid contact with genitalia.

TO CONTROL FLEAS AND TICKS ON PREMISES:

Apply as a direct spray to control accessible <sup>stages</sup> ~~states~~ of fleas and ticks. Spray to lightly dampen absorbent surfaces or to the point of runoff on non-absorbent surfaces. Thoroughly spray infested areas, pet beds and resting quarters, cracks and crevices, along baseboards, moldings and window and door frames, as well as localized areas of floor and floor covering. Repeat as necessary.

TO CONTROL CRAWLING INSECTS:

Apply as directed to control accessible stages of crawling insects including, but not limited to, cockroaches, ants, fleas, ticks, spiders, silverfish, and crickets. Spray to thoroughly wet exposed insects. Direct spray into hiding places, cracks and crevices, along baseboards, and around floor and window frames.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Wrap container in several layers of newspapers and discard in trash.
