REMOVE SCORCH AND STAINS Such as medicine. Dip with cotton or linen fabrics. Remove starch. Mix 3 tablespoons of BLEACH with water. Stir well. Soak fabric 5 to 10 minutes. If brown stains from ink remain, remove with vinegar.

BRIGHTEN PAINTED WOODWORK (Drainboards, Shelves, Wooden Utensils) 1/2 Tablespoons of BLEACH in 1 gallon of cold water.

GENERAL USE Ranges, food utensils, kettles, wicker, vases, bottles wash thoroughly with solution of 1/2 tablespoon of BLEACH in 1 gallon of cold water.

BLEACH FLOORS Wash floors. Mix 1/2 gallon of cold water. Apply and let stand for 10 minutes. To bleach floor mops, dish cloths, dish towels, strong suds containing BLEACH.

BRIGHTEN PAINTED WOODWORK-Drain paint from Shelves, Wooden Utensils-2 Tablespoons of BLEACH in 1 gallon of cold water.

GENERAL USE-Ranges, food utensils, wicker, vases, bottles-wash thoroughly, then in solution of 2 tablespoons of BLEACH in 1 gallon of water.

BLEACH FLOORS-Wash floors, Mix 1/2 cup of BLEACH in 1 gallon of cold water. Apply and let stand for 10 minutes. To bleach floor mops, dish cloths, dish towels, wash in strong suds containing BLEACH.

USE ONLY ON WHITE AND FAST COLORS • DO NOT USE ON SILK, WOOL, LEATHERS

BLEACH CLOTHES-If you soak clothes, add tablespoon of BLEACH to each gallon of cold or lukewarm water. Stir well. Add soap powder or soap flakes. Put in white cotton or linen clothes. Soak half-hour or overnight. Wash as usual; rinse.-If you do not soak clothes, add tablespoon of BLEACH to each gallon of first water. Stir, put in white clothes. Let stand ten minutes, then rinse.

REMOVE SCORCH AND STAINS-Such as; fruit, ink, berry, medicine. Dip with cotton or linen fabrics in cold water to remove starch. Mix 3 tablespoons of BLEACH in quart of cold water. Stir well. Soak fabric 5 to 10 minutes. Rinse thoroughly. If brown stains from ink remain, remove with lemon juice or vinegar.

BRIGHTEN PAINTED WOODWORK-Drainboards, Breadboards, Shelves, Wooden Utensils-2 Tablespoons of BLEACH in quart of cold water.

GENERAL USE-Ranges, food utensils, linoleum, windows, wicker, vases, bottles-wash thoroughly, then rinse with fresh solution of 2 tablespoons of BLEACH in a quart of cold water.

BLEACH FLOORS-Wash floors, Mix 1/2 pint of BLEACH to a gallon of cold water. Apply and let stand for 10 minutes. Rinse. To bleach floor mops, dish cloths, dish towels, etc., wash in strong suds containing BLEACH.

AVOID TRANSFER TO FOOD OR BEVERAGE CONTAINERS.

MILDEW-Soak white cotton or linen fabric (NOT SILK OR WOOL) in cold water about 15 Min. Then reimmerse fabric in solution of 3 tablespoons of BLEACH to each qt. of water for ten minutes. Hang in sunlight.

REFRIGERATOR-To clean, Disinfect and Deodorize. Thoroughly wash inside surface and shelves. Then keep wet for 5 Min. with a solution of 3 tablespoons of BLEACH to each qt. of warm water. Rinse well with plain water. Air Dry.

DRAIN PIPES-To clean and deodorize, flush with boiling water, then add cup of BLEACH.

SICK ROOM-Wash all utensils, then place in BLEACH solution for 5 minutes, 3 tablespoons of BLEACH to each quart of hot water. Rinse. Dry.

TOILET BOWLS-Deodorize with few drops of BLEACH. For stains, use 1/2 cup of BLEACH and a few drops of vinegar. Let stand overnight.

WHITEN PORCELAINS AND TILE-For bathtubs, sinks, wash basins, marble-2 tablespoons BLEACH in quart of cold water. Rinse surface.

DISINFECTANT-Dish cloths, handkerchiefs, diapers, etc. First wash in clear water, immerse for 5 minutes in solution of 3 tablespoons of BLEACH to each quart of cold or lukewarm water. Rinse and dry.

CAUTION - DO NOT USE BLEACH WITH AMMONIA OR TOILET BOWL CLEANERS.

This product will irritate skin or eyes. Flood and rinse immediately with plenty of water. If taken internally, drink milk, white of egg or feed cooked cereal. Call a Physician.
