#### AS A CLEANSER AND DEODORIZER FOLLOW DIRECTIONS CAREFULLY

SAFE for COTTON, LINEN, NYLON, ORLON, DACRON

FOR DEODORIZING: Toilet bowls, wash bowls and drain pipes, occasionally pour in a cupful of **Bleach**. To remove stains and odor in toilet bowls, pour one cupful of **Bleach** into bowl, then add three tablespoonfuls of vinegar. Let stand an hour or overnight.

GARBAGE CANS: Empty and wash. Then rinse with one-half cup of Bleach to each gallon of warm water. Bleach dropped on the inside rim of the can is particularly effective for preventing odors during hot weather.

#### AS A BLEACHING AGENT FOR REGULAR LAUNDRY WORK FOLLOW DIRECTIONS

FOR HAND LAUNDERING AND BLEACHING: Soop and wash clothes in the usual manner. In a separate tub thoroughly mix one cupful of **Bleach** to each five to six gallons of water. Immerse soaped clothes. Soak for one-half hour if warm water is used, two or three hours or overnight if cold water is used. Wring out and rinse twice in clear water. Leaves clothes pure and white. Boiling or bluing unnecessary.

Especially good for baby's laundry. Stubborn stains and odors are quickly removed from diapers and bed clothing, leaving them spotlessly white and sanitary without boiling.

FOR WASHING MACHINE: Prepare your wash water as usual with soap, chips or flakes. Add one cupful of Bleach to each five to six gallons of water. Mix thoroughly before immersing clothes. Run the machine for one-half hour or more. Rinse twice in clear water and then hang to dry. TO REMOVE SCORCH AND MILDEW FROM WHITE COTTONS OR LINENS: First soak fabric in cold water to remove starch. Prepare solution of two tablespoons of Bleach to each quart of cold or lukewarm water. Mix well. Immerse fabric, soak for ten minutes, longer if necessary. Rinse thoroughly. Hang in sunlight until final traces disappear.

A great time saver on Wash Day! **Bleach** cleanses and removes ordinary stains in the usual laundering process from white and fast colored cottons and linens. Stubborn stains may be removed by a slightly stronger solution.

FOR CLEANING: Refrigerators, vegetable pans, cupboards, puntries and pantry shelves, bread and cake boxes, etc., wash with a solution of two tablespoonfuls of **Bleach** to each quart of water. Rinse thoroughly with clear water. For painted woodwork, marble, tile, enamel, porcelain, linoleum, window panes, glass, both tubs, sinks, crockery, etc., wash with a solution of two tablespoonfuls of **Bleach** to each quart of water. Rinse well.
