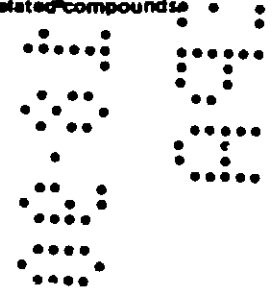

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For rapid control of roaches, ants, spiders, cri-
 centipades, cheese mites, meal worms, grain be-
 flour beetles, red flour beetles) and weevils (e-
 rice weevils): Apply in a good sprayer adjust-
 coarse wet spray, at a rate of 1 gallon to 750
 surface. Direct spray into locations where they
 found; garbage compactors, garbage chutes,
 cracks and crevices, dark corners, behind and
 stoves, refrigerators, and cabinets, along baseboard
 door and window frames. Spray ant trails, nest
 entry. Spray insects directly wherever possible.

In case of infested foods in cabinets, dispose
 material. Remove all contents and clean the
 interior surfaces of empty cabinets thoroughly.
 has dried, cover shelves with paper or otherwise
 from direct contact with sprayed surfaces.

Repeat treatment if reinfestation occurs.
