**Lice:** Spray in an inconspicuous area to avoid possible staining or discoloration after drying, then promptly. Spray only those garments, bedding, including mattresses that cannot be either washed or dry cleaned.

These pests are found or may be found in dark corners of rooms, closets, along baseboards, door sills, under and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and around garbage cans, near utility installations. Pests should be sprayed directly on nests and points of entry, as necessary.

Use in an inconspicuous area to test for discoloration. Inspect again and proceed to spray entire area. Wash garments and parts of mattresses, and furniture cleaner laundered or dry cleaned.

**Dog Ticks:** Thoroughly spray animals. Spray infested baseboards, windows and door frames, floor coverings where localized ticks occur. Applications should be necessary. Fresh bedding should be changed in quarters following treatment.

**To Control Fleas Indoors:** Thoroughly apply as a spray for spot treatment to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, along and behind baseboards, window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present.
