**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with labeling.

**TO DISINFECT AND DEODORIZE TOILET BOWLS:** Remove water from bowl. Pour disinfectant, mixed one cup per gallon of water, into bowl. Swab bowl thoroughly, especially under rim and at water outlet.

**TO DISINFECT AND DEODORIZE GARBAGE AND REFUSE CANS:** Empty container and remove heavy soil. Mix one cup of disinfectant per gallon of water. Apply this solution liberally to all surfaces of the container and swab or brush thoroughly. If the container was extremely dirty, rinse and redo.

**TO DEODORIZE FLOORS AND OTHER HARD SURFACES:** Remove heavy soil by sweeping or wet mopping. Mix one cup of this product per gallon of water. Apply liberally with mop or spray so that all areas are reached.

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**Hazard to Humans and Domestic Animals**

**WARNING:** Keep out of reach of children. Causes eye or skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food.
