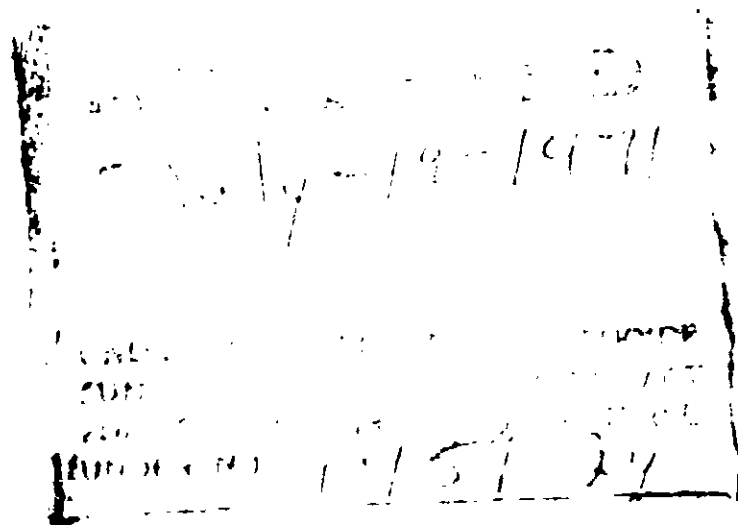

Keep Away From Heat • Store In Cool Place

TO CLEAN AND DEODORIZE TOILET BOWLS: Hold mop over bowl and pour one ounce of cleaner over head of mop. Swab entire area thoroughly.

TO DISINFECT, DEODORIZE AND CLEAN ENCRUSTED TOILET BOWLS: Remove water from bowl by forcing over trap with bowl mop. Squeeze water from mop. Pour one or two ounces of cleaner over mop. Swab bowl, especially under rim at water outlet. Flush and rinse toilet and mop.

TO CLEAN, DISINFECT AND DEODORIZE URINALS: Place mop over trap. Saturate with one to one and one half ounces of cleaner. Swab entire urinal, with special attention to outlet and grooves along side. Remove screen at trap and pour one or two ounces of cleaner around drain opening. Wait two or three minutes — let the cleaner do the work, swab inside of pipe thoroughly. Replace screen and flush.

DO NOT USE on enamel or porcelain coated surfaces. Avoid spilling on nylon.

POISON

Contains Hydrochloric Acid

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

DANGER: Corrosive: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Fatal if swallowed. Do not breathe vapor or fumes. Produces chemical burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.

ANTIDOTE: Internal — Call a physician immediately. Drink a teaspoonful or more of magnesia, chalk, or small pieces of soap, softened with water in milk or raw egg white.

External — Eyes — Wash with water for 15 minutes. Get prompt medical attention. Skin — Wipe off the acid gently, immediately flood the surface with water, using soap freely, then cover with moist magnesia or baking soda.

NOTE: Close container when not in use. When bottle is empty, rinse thoroughly with water before discarding.
