DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR GENERAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTION USE 1:256 SOLUTION (1/2 oz. per gallon of water).

For simplicity, accuracy and portion control, use concentrate with dispenser supplied with bottles. One stroke of dispenser (pull up, then press down) delivers 1/2 ounce, the correct amount for each gallon of solution prepared.

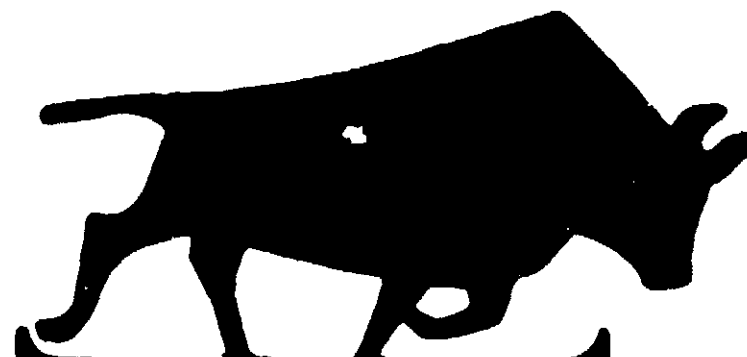
For best results, apply liberally with a cloth or mop to walls, floors and other hard surfaces. For removing heavy soil or organic matter, use as above, pick up dirty solution and reclean surface.

If used for sanitation of food equipment or other food contact items, limit level of active quaternary to 200 ppm (1 oz. to 5 gal. water). Treated food contact surfaces and equipment must be rinsed with potable water prior to reuse.

Rinse empty bottle thoroughly with water before discarding.
