PHENOL COEFFICIENTS: *Staphylococcus aureus* 78, *Salmonella typhosa* 48.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: FOR GENERAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTING OF FLOORS, WALLS AND OTHER HARD SURFACES: Mix one ounce per gallon of water. Apply liberally with a cloth, mop or sprayer. When removing heavy soil or organic matter, use as above, pick up dirty solution and reclean surface.

SANITIZING: If used for sanitization of previously cleaned equipment or food contact items, limit the level of active quaternaries to 200 ppm (1.4 ounces per 5-gallon of water). No rinse required at this level.

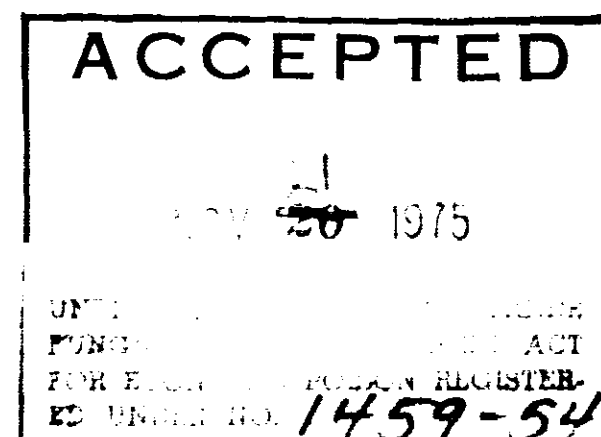

DANGER: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Corrosive. Causes severe eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contamination of food. Protect eyes and skin when handling concentrate.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash all contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink milk, egg whites, gelatin solution, or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Call a physician.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard.
