DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ADD [It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use 2 1/2 to 3 gallons undiluted weed-killer per 1000 sq. ft. of soil surface (100-200 gal. per acre). Spray uniformly and thoroughly wet all foliage to insure contact action. Best results are obtained if used when weeds are just beginning to sprout and are growing rapidly.

Where vegetation is tall and dense, use 5 gals. per 1000 sq. ft. (200 gal. per acre). For control of hard-to-kill perennial weeds and grasses such as Johnson grass, bindweed and wild carrot, use 8 to 12 gals. per 1,000 sq. ft.

Although it has considerable activity through foliage contact, much of this weed killers activity is through the roots and, therefore, adequate rainfall or watering is necessary.

Under conditions where the rainfall is high and the growing season long, a second application may be necessary to maintain a weed-free soil surface.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD
