DIRECTIONS FOR USE • GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

TO DISINFECT, CLEAN AND DEODORIZE hard, non-porous surfaces such as bathroom tiles, fixtures, shower stalls, walls, sinks and bathtubs proceed as follows:

(1) Hold container 6 to 8 inches from surface to be treated. (2) Spray area until covered with solution. Allow to penetrate and remain wet for 10 minutes. No scrubbing necessary. (3) Wipe off with clean cloth or sponge. For heavily soiled areas, remove gross soil before treatment.

TO CONTROL MOLD AND MILDEW on hard, non-porous surfaces such as floors, walls, table tops, spray the surface to be treated, making sure to wet completely. Let air dry. Repeat applications at weekly intervals or when mildew growth reappears.

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: Keep Out of Reach of Children. Causes eye and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. Harmful if swallowed.
