DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO CLEAN, SANITIZE & DEODORIZE CARPETS: Vacuum carpet before cleaning... **FOR EXTRACTION USE:** Mix two ounces of this sanitizing carpet-cleaner per gallon of water. Inject and extract as you would with other "steam cleaning" shampoos... **FOR BONNET CLEANING:** Mix four ounces of this sanitizing shampoo per gallon of water. Spray on carpet at rate of 200-300 sq. ft. per gallon. Scrub with rotary floor machine equipped with spray-clean bonnet or pad.

NOTE: Test for color fastness of carpet before use. Apply dilute cleaner to a small out of the way spot of carpet, then rub with clean white cloth. If color transfers to cloth or changes, a water base product should not be used.

After cleaning, set carpet pile in one direction with a stiff brush. Place aluminum foil or waxed paper under legs of furniture, while carpet is drying... Over wetting can cause shrinking of carpet. Manufacturer assumes no responsibility for over wetting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep this product under locked storage sufficient to make it inaccessible to children or persons unfamiliar with its proper use. Store only in original container. Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
