Dear Mr. Fryatt,

The following amendment submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA, as amended, acceptable with the conditions listed below.

- Update first aid statements per PR Notice 2001-1

Conditions

Revise the label as follows:

1. In the 1st paragraph above the "Precautionary Statements, revise the 4th statement to read "*Will not harm washable synthetic fibers.*"
2. Based on the Agency letter dated December 7, 1998, this product's acute oral toxicity category is III, you must add the statement, "*Harmful if swallowed.*" You may revise the third statement in this section to read "*Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin.*"
3. Under the Directions for Use, delete the heading, "to clean, sanitize, and deodorize carpets," because the information following the heading does not provide adequate directions. You must revise the section to reflect the following:

Vacuum carpet before cleaning.

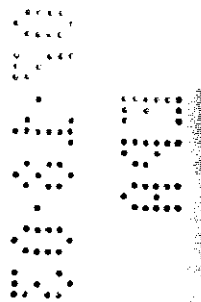

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
TO CLEAN, SANITIZE & DEODORIZE CARPETS: Vacuum carpets before cleaning.
FOR EXTRACTION USE- Mix two ounces of this sanitizing carpet cleaner per gallon of water. Inject and extract as you would with other "steam cleaning" shampoos.
FOR BONNET CLEANING- Mix one part carpet cleaner with eight parts (16 oz. per gallon) of warm water. Spray on carpet at the rate of 200-300 sq. ft. per gallon. Scrub with rotary floor machine equipped with spray-clean bonnet or pad.

NOTE: Test for color change on a small, inconspicuous spot of carpet before cleaning. After cleaning, use wax paper underlay on carpet. Manufacturer's instructions should be followed.

Do not discharge into oceans, or other bodies of water. Discharge Elimination Information is available in writing prior to sale of this product. Do not use in systems without contact your State Department of Environmental Control (if container size is 5 gallons or more).

Keep product out of reach of children. Rinse and discard in household trash (if container size is 5 gallons or more).

Do not contaminate water. PESTICIDE STORAGE: Keep product out of reach of children. Do not reuse empty container. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are acutely toxic. Always follow label instructions for disposal. Hazardous Waste Identification Number: 261-282-1. Triple rinse (or equivalent) and dispose of in a safe manner. If burned, it will produce toxic fumes.
