

NOTIFICATION OF LABEL CHANGES FOR EPA REG NO 1459-74, SANITIZING/DEODORIZING CARPET CLEANER FOR EXTRACTION AND BONNET CLEANING

- 1. Changes in marketing language, top left panel and addition of non-pesticidal effectiveness claim: "...and remove mildew stains."

A sanitizing, low-foam ~~shampoo~~ carpet cleaner ~~for use with all models of extraction and carpet "steam cleaning" equipment.~~ Contains ~~modern~~ containing quaternary ammonium compounds to reduce the number of putrefactive bacteria and remove mildew stains. 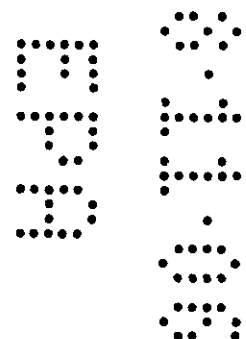
- 2. Addition of two additional methods of application, bottom left panel under "DIRECTIONS FOR USE":

SPRAY & BRUSH CLEANING: Mix one part cleaner with eight parts water (16 oz. per gal). Spray evenly over carpet to remain wet for 10 minutes. Then brush into carpet with a light machine or manually.
SPOT CLEANING: Mix one part cleaner with eight parts water and apply liberally with sprayer or flip cap. With soft cloth or brush, rub spot from edge towards its center.

- 3. Change of wording and typo correction (addition of the word "not") under "NOTE:" bottom left and top right panel.

NOTE: Test for color fastness of carpet before use. Apply dilute cleaner to a small out of the way spot of carpet, then rub with clean white cloth. If color transfers to cloth or changes, a water based product should not be used.
