NOTIFICATION OF LABEL CHANGES FOR EPA REG NO 1459-74, SANITIZING/DEODORIZING CARPET CLEANER FOR EXTRACTION AND BONNET CLEANING

1. Changes in marketing language, top left panel and addition of non-pesticidal effectiveness claim: "...and remove mildew stains."

A sanitizing, low-foam—shampee carpet cleaner for use with all models of extraction and earpet "steam eleaning" equipment. Contains modern containing quaternary ammonium compounds to reduce the number of putrefactive bacteria and remove mildew stains. Fortified with AIRICIDE® Odor Counteractant to neutralize unpleasant odors from other sources. Will not harm washable synthetic fibers. Contains built in defeamers and optical brighteners. Removes greasy soil. Leaves no residue sticky film to promote resoiling. Eliminates soil redeposition in vacuum pick up tanks.


2. Addition of two additional methods of application, bottom left panel under "DIRECTIONS FOR USE":
