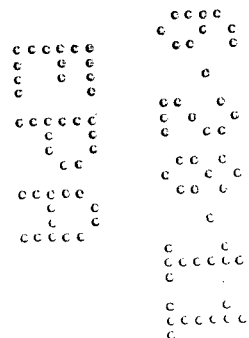

TO CLEAN, SANITIZE, AND DEODORIZE CARPETS THROUGH BONNET CLEANING: Mix one part carpet cleaner to eight parts (16 oz. per gallon) of warm water. Spray on carpet at the rate of 200-300 sq. ft. per gallon. Scrub rotary floor machine equipped with spray-clean bonnet or pad.

SPRAY & BRUSH CLEANING: Mix one part cleaner with eight parts water (16 oz. per gal.). Spray evenly over carpet to remain wet 10 minutes. Then brush into carpet with a light machine or manually.

SPOT CLEANING: Mix one part cleaner with eight parts water and apply liberally with sprayer or flip cap. With soft cloth or brush, rub spot from edge towards its center.

**NOTIFICATION OF LABEL CHANGES FOR EPA REG NO 1459-74,
SANITIZING/DEODORIZING CARPET FOR EXTRATION AND BONNET CLEANING**

Below are changes to the container disposal language per PR Notice 2007-4:

(If container size is one gallon or less, use the following Storage and Disposal statements -)
