

An effective disinfectant cleaner and deodorant for hospitals, homes, motels, hotels, schools, nursing homes, nurseries, factories, business and industrial buildings, restaurants, food plants, boats, campers and automobile and airplane interiors.

Cleans and deodorizes porcelain, tile, grouting, stainless steel, enameled surfaces, woodwork, formica, leather, vinyl, and plastic.

Use it on counter tops, stove tops, exhaust fans, washable walls, sinks, shower stalls, bed frames, vinyl, leather and plastic upholstery.

1. **Cleaning and Disinfecting:** Hold sprayer nozzle 6 to 8 inches from the surface to be cleaned. Thoroughly wet the area. Allow the solution to penetrate for about one minute and then wipe away the soil with a clean cloth or sponge. The wiping cloth may be predampened with water or with this product.
2. **For Disinfection:** Before disinfecting, preclean the surface as in Step 1 above. Then, apply enough fresh solution to thoroughly wet the surface. Allow the disinfecting solution to contact surfaces for 10 minutes before wiping or rinsing the treatment from the surfaces.
