

**Ready - to - use, Non-Abrasive Formula**

**DIRECTIONS:**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. An effective disinfectant, cleaner and deodorant for hospitals, homes, motels, hotels, schools, nursing homes, nurseries, factories, business and industrial buildings, restaurants, food plants, boats, campers and automobile and airplane interiors.

Cleans and deodorizes porcelain, tiling, grouting, stainless steel, enameled surfaces, woodwork, formica, leather, vinyl and plastic. Use it on counter tops, stove tops, exhaust fans, washable walls, sinks, shower stalls, toilet bowls, urinals, bed frames, vinyl, leather and plastic upholstery.

1. **FOR GENERAL CLEANING AND DEODORIZING:** Hold sprayer nozzle 6 to 8 inches from the surface to be cleaned. Thoroughly wet the area. Allow the solution to penetrate for about one minute and then wipe away the soil with a clean cloth or sponge. Do not breathe spray mist.

The wiping cloth may be predampened with water or with this product.

2. **FOR DISINFECTION:** Before disinfecting, pre-clean the surface as in Step 1 above. Then, apply enough fresh solution to thoroughly wet the surface. Allow the disinfecting solution to contact surfaces for 10 minutes before wiping or rinsing the treatment from the surfaces.

3. **TO DISINFECT, CLEAN AND DEODORIZE TOILET BOWLS AND URINALS:**(1) Push water out of the bowl by plunging head of bowl mop into the trap. Then squeeze water from the mop head by pressing it against the inside of the bowl. (2) Pour 1-2 oz. of this product over strands of mop and spread evenly over surface to be cleaned. Scrub surface with mop, especially under flush ring. (3) Allow surface to remain wet for at least 10 minutes before flushing.....Preliminary cleaning is required to disinfect heavily soiled surfaces.

4. **FOR MILDEW:** Follow directions for disinfection. Repeat treatment every 2 weeks or when mildew growth first reappears.

5. **VENTILATION AND AIR CONDITIONING DUCT WORK SANITIZING:** Duct work should be mechanically cleaned, vacuumed or blown free of dirt, dust, mold and debris, using a commercially available duct cleaning system or service.

Spray or fog this product solution into duct work using a suitable spraying or fogging device. Make sure that the surfaces are thoroughly wet for at least 60 seconds. During application, area must be closed as tightly as possible and sealed. After spraying or fogging, the area should be opened and aired for one (1) hour before repopulating. Do not breathe spray mist. Use an applicable NIOSH/MSHA approved respirator appropriate for fogging or spraying this product. After application, allow to air dry. Treat as required. FOGGING IS TO BE USED AS AN ADJUNCT TO ACCEPTABLE MANUAL CLEANING AND DISINFECTING OF SURFACES.

This product is recommended for use on exhaust fans, metal ducts and filters, coils and drain pans of air conditioning and refrigeration equipment and heat pumps.

**NOTE:** This product may be used on food contact surfaces but surfaces must be thoroughly rinsed with potable water surfaces before they are permitted to recontact food.
