DIRECTIONS FOR USE

INDOOR APPLICATION:

The use of this product in food processing establishments should be confined to time periods when the plant is not in operation. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned with potable water before using.

Vacate treated areas and ventilate before reoccupying.

For maximum effectiveness, a combination of spot, surface treatment and fogging is recommended.

SURFACE SPRAYING: To control Cockroaches, Paimetto Bugs, Ants, Sliverfish, Spiders, Crickets, Clovermites, Cheese Miles, Granary Weevils, Rice Weevils, Confused Flour Beetles, Rust Red Flour Beetles, Sawtoothed Grain Beatles, Spider Beatles, Cigarette Beatles, Drugstore Beetles, Meal Worms, Grain Mites and Cadelles: Use a good sprayer adjusted to a coarse wet spray.
