

DIRECTIONS

Use as is — do not dilute with water or mix it with any other chemicals. First, thoroughly clean, rinse and dry the toilet fixtures. Apply to such areas as flush handles, interior and rim surfaces of toilets and urinals and to top and bottom surfaces of toilet seat. Use a trigger — or finger — sprayer to apply so as to thoroughly wet the surfaces. Allow two minutes for it to act. Remove excess with clean dry cloth or toilet tissue. The used tissue may be disposed of by flushing through toilet.

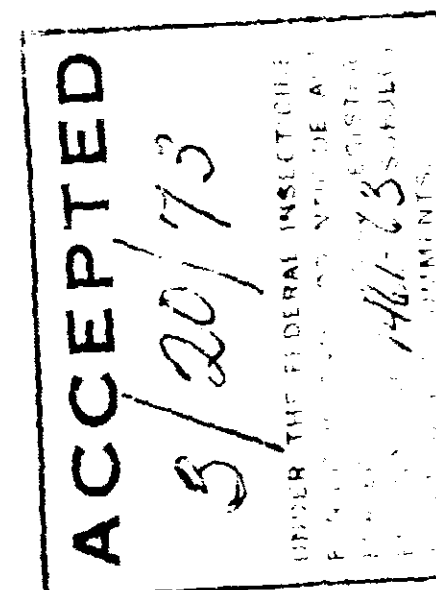
