### Directions for Barber and Beauty Shop Use.

- 1) Sanitize brushes, combs, scissors, razors, cutters, manicure sets, and other equipment.
  - 2) Wash instruments being careful that they are free from hair and other accumulations.
  - 3) Rinse thoroughly in clear water.
  - 4) Dip in a solution, using 2 1/2 table-spoons disinfectant to 2 quarts of water for at least one minute, being careful to immerse instruments completely.
  - 5) Remove from solution, air-dry and store in a clean dry place.
- Solution should be changed twice a week, or sooner if it clouds.

### CAUTION

Avoid contamination of food.  
Do not use in conjunction with soaps or synthetic detergents.

### Directions for Dairy, Restaurant, Industrial and Home Use

For sanitation of dairy equipment, wash thoroughly with soap and water, then rinse with 1 ounce disinfectant to 1 gallon of water.

### DIRTY - DO NOT USE A TOWEL

For sanitation of milk cans and miscellaneous dairy equipment, clean and rinse thoroughly. Wash in disinfectant solution using 1 ounce disinfectant to 3 gallons of water or spray using 1 ounce disinfectant to 2 gallons of water. A solution of 1 ounce disinfectant to 5 gallons of water is recommended for use in wiping flanks and udder prior to milking.

For general use in sanitizing bath tubs, toilet seats, floor walls, bathtubs, showers, and pipes. Apply freely after cleansing using 1 ounce disinfectant to 2 gallons of water.

Excellent sanitizer for final rinse in laundry.

Can be used as a deodorant. Use 1 part disinfectant to 10 parts of water.
