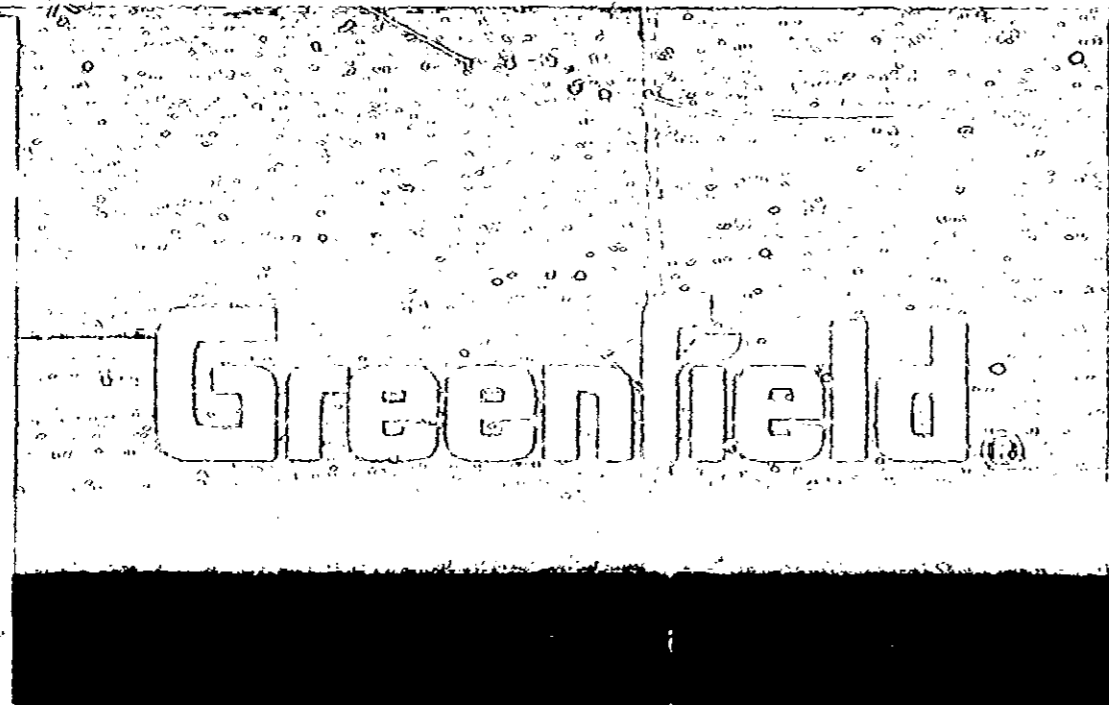


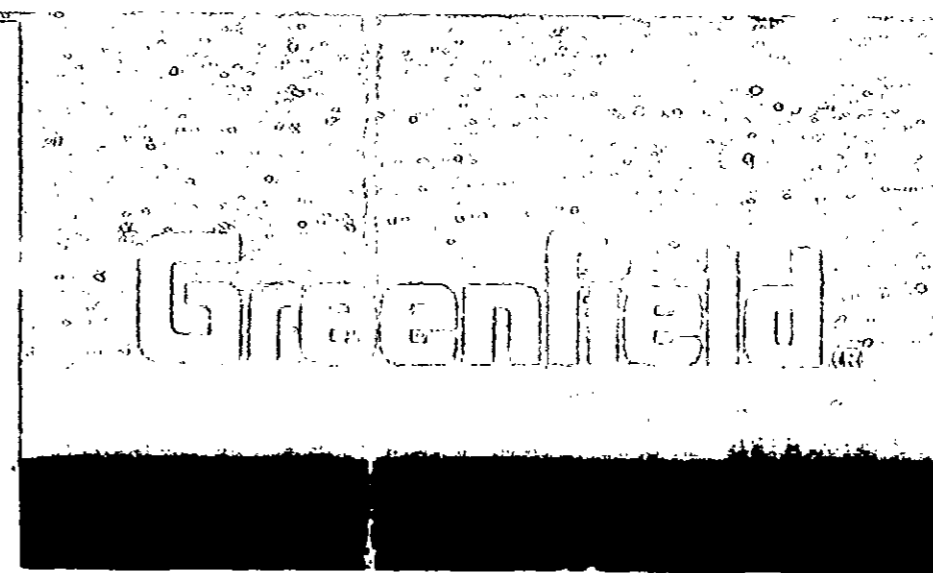

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

AROUND ESTABLISHED PLANTS—flowers*, ornamental plants, trees and listed vegetables at least 2 to 3 inches tall

BEFORE PLANTING VEGETABLES—use only on those listed in Special Instructions below

WHERE TO APPLY: Apply PREEN around shrubs, trees and the flowers and vegetables listed below. Do not apply to ground covers or flowers from bulbs other than those listed. PREEN is not intended for lawns. On lawns use Greenfield CARBICIDE[®].

WHEN TO APPLY: Apply PREEN as early as possible in the growing season to take advantage of the season-long weed control it provides. Or you can apply PREEN any time of the year around shrubs, trees, and similar established plants.

WEEDS CONTROLLED: PREEN keeps out the broad range of weeds listed below. PREEN prevents new weeds, but does not affect established growing weeds. PREEN will not harm desirable plants under normal growing conditions if used as directed.

LENGTH OF PROTECTION: One proper application of PREEN lasts through the entire growing season. Rain does not wash out PREEN. Shallow cultivation does not affect PREEN if properly mixed into the soil. Natural soil organisms eventually break down PREEN, requiring a fresh application the following year.

*Recommended for use on the following established flowers: Achillea, Ageratum, Arctotis, Aster, Balsam, Calendula, California Poppy, Calliopsis, Carnation, Centaurea, Chrysanthemum, Cosmos, Dahlia, Dianthus, Dimorphotheca, Forget-me-not, Four O'Clock, Gaillardia, Gladiolus (corms more than 1" in diameter), Hollyhock, Impatiens, Lettuce, Lupines, Marigold, Morning Glory, Nasturtium, Nicotiana, Penstemon, Petunia, Phlox, Portulaca, Ruellia, Salvia, Scabiosa, Spirea, Verbena, Zinnia
