## DIRECTIONS FOR USE

WHAT IT DOES: This lightweight, double action product (1) feeds with a 12-16-8 plant food, specially formulated for acid-loving evergreens, azaleas, and others, (2) prevents broadleaf and grassy weeds\* from getting started in planting beds. Safe to apply to established evergreens, shrubs, other ornamental plants.

WHEN TO USE: Apply in spring as evergreen and shrub growth begins and before weeds become established. Make a second application about 4 weeks later for maximum weed control.

HOW TO USE: Follow directions exactly for best results.

- 1. Before application, remove all existing broadleaf and grassy weeds since product kills sprouting seeds, but will not kill weeds after they're established.
- Punch in handy perforations at top of can for easy spreading.
  Or, remove metal lid and pour into smaller can for spreading.
- 3. Spread as evenly as possible. Avoid missing small areas since weeds will grow in spots not covered by product.
- 4. Spread contents of this can over 400 sq. ft. of soil area. A second application should be made 4 weeks later for continued weed control. Or, spread one-half of contents of this can on 200 sq. ft. now and remaining contents on same area in 4 weeks. Working product into soil lightly gives maximum weed control and fertilizer activity.
- 5. After application, sprinkle shrubs lightly to remove any of the product from foliage. Peat moss or other mulches can be spread without reducing product's effectiveness.
