## GENERAL DIRECTIONS

### For Flowers:

TUTANE<sup>®</sup> is recommended for the prevention of flower rot of gladiolus and chrysanthemum caused

by *Botrytis* during storage and transit. TUTANE will not injure or leave a visible residue on the treated flowers, leaves, or stems. TUTANE may be applied both as a pre- and post-harvest spray.

## APPLICATION DIRECTIONS

### Gladiolus and Chrysanthemum:

**Pre-harvest:** Flowers, leaves and stems should be sprayed until uniformly wet. Spray within 48 hours before cutting.

**Post-harvest:** Cut flowers, leaves and stems should

be sprayed until uniformly wet. Spray immediately before packaging so that moisture is still present when the treated material is placed in the shipping box. Best disease control is obtained when flowers are packed while they are still wet.

## MIXING DIRECTIONS

Apply at the rate of 4 ounces of TUTANE solution per one gallon of water as a spray for both pre-

harvest or post-harvest application. Wear goggles when preparing working solution.

## SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Do not hold mixed solution in drums or spray tanks longer than three days. Do not store material where it will be exposed to direct light or temperature extremes.

**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Wash well after contact; if splashed into eyes, flush with copious amounts of water. If irritation persists, get medical attention. If skin should become irritated from alkalinity of solutions, rinse with dilute vinegar and use emollients. Insure adequate ventilation throughout

work and storage areas. When material is to be disposed of, insure at least a 200X dilution of working solutions (2%) before discharging into waste systems. Avoid contamination of foodstuffs, feeds and fishponds.
