The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Revise the fifth sentence under precautionary statements to read as follows: Wear goggles or face shield and protective clothing such as coveralls, a long-sleeved shirt and impermeable gloves when handling product.

3. Submit five (5) copies of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

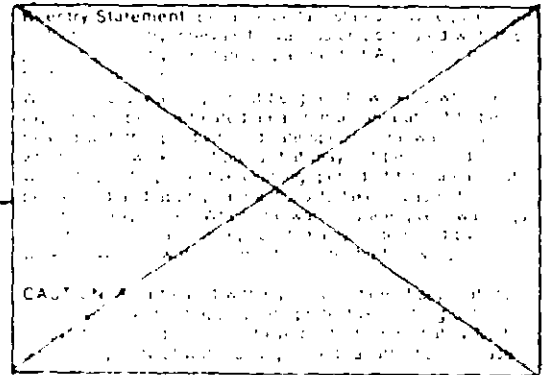

and applied as a spray to the foliage of ornamental plants. Sufficient pressure should be used in spraying Pipron to ensure thorough coverage of all plant surfaces. Special care should be taken to thoroughly wet new terminal growth and plant areas already diseased with powdery mildew.

MIXING: Pour the recommended amount of Pipron and surfactant into the spray tank during filling and mix thoroughly before spraying.

Rates and spraying schedule: To control powdery mildew, add to each 100 gallons of water 1/4-1/2 pint of Pipron Liquid Concentrate plus 2-4 fluid ounces of one of the following surfactants:

Triton® B-1956®

No Foam® B

Stepanol® WA Paste (Not For Use in California)

Begin spraying soon after the first leaves expand or the first symptoms of powdery mildew appear. Use the higher rates if powdery mildew is already present. Apply every seven to ten days, or as needed.

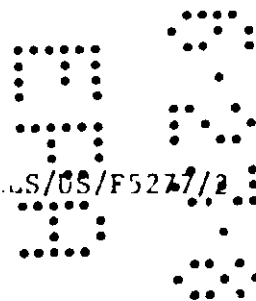

WARNING

Statements of Practical Treatment

If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation develops.

If on skin: Wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation develops.

If inhaled: If discomfort occurs, remove individual to fresh air. If breathing difficulty occurs, get medical attention. If not breathing, provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation and get medical attention immediately.

If swallowed: Do not induce vomiting. Call a physician or poison control center. If available, administer activated charcoal (6-8 heaping teaspoonfuls) with a large quantity of water. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Immediately transport to a medical care facility and see a physician (see Notes to Physician).

Notes to Physician: This product contains an aromatic hydrocarbon and can be extremely harmful if swallowed. Aspiration of this product may produce a severe pneumonitis. Stomach lavage with a cuffed endotracheal tube in place and immediate administration of activated charcoal, 6-8 heaping teaspoonfuls with water, should be considered. Treatment is otherwise symptomatic and supportive.

Environmental Hazards

Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment wash water.
