DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SURFLAN, when applied according to label directions, either alone or in combination with Sencor or Lexone, provides effective control of those weeds and grasses noted on the SURFLAN label, as well as providing partial control or suppression of red rice (*Oryza sativa* L.)

RECOMMENDATIONS

Soil Preparation

Destroy existing weeds before applying SURFLAN and prepare the soil as recommended in existing labeling.

Application

Apply SURFLAN alone or in combination with either Sencor or Lexone up to two weeks prior to planting, at rates presently recommended for your soil type, and in a manner otherwise consistent with existing labeling for the preplant surface application of SURFLAN.

Soil Bed Preparation

Shallow till the soil following application and prior to planting to prepare the seedbed and remove any red rice plants that may have already germinated. Suitable tillage equipment includes: Lely Rotator, cultimulcher, mulch treader, spring tooth harrow, bed conditioner (Do-All), Triple K, or field cultivator. Equipment should be operated at an angle to the direction of planting.

Special Precautions

Do not use a disc or other deep running tillage implements after applying SURFLAN, as crop injury may occur.

Failure to follow label directions could result in reduced or erratic weed and grass control and in reduced red rice suppression.

Refer to existing SURFLAN label prior to application, and always read and follow label directions carefully.
