

ADDENDUM: GENERAL USE INFORMATION FOR SPIKE 20P

SPIKE 20P may be applied for the control of brush and woody plants on sites listed on the product label. Lower than recommended rates may be applied if partial control is desired.

SPIKE 20P FOR CONTROL OF ALLIGATOR, ONESEED,  
UTAH AND ROCKY MOUNTAIN JUNIPER SPECIES

Apply SPIKE 20P by ground or aerial broadcast equipment capable of accurate calibration and able to provide a uniform distribution of pellets on the soil surface. SPIKE 20P may be applied by ground or air broadcast by or under the supervision of U.S. government agencies.

Broadcast Application Rates

Apply SPIKE 20P at 10 to 20 pounds per acre. Lower than recommended rates may be applied if partial control is desired.

Species Controlled

Juniper, alligator (Juniperus deppeana)\*  
Juniper, oneseed (Juniperus monosperma)  
Juniper, rocky mountain (Juniperus scopulorum)  
Juniper, Utah (Juniperus osteosperma)

\* Treat only regrowth stands with small trees

Precaution

Use of application equipment not capable of confining the spread of pellets to the target area may result in injury or death of desirable vegetation outside the intended treatment area.
