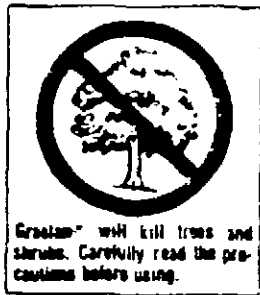

DIRECTIONS FOR USE—Read All Directions Carefully Before Applying

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with the label.

GRASLAN Brush Bullets herbicide is intended for control of individual trees or low density or scattered stands of brush which do not warrant broadcast application.

GRASLAN Brush Bullets may be applied any time except when the soil surface is frozen, snow covered or saturated with water. Apply GRASLAN Brush Bullets to the soil surface. Distribute the proper dose within the drip zone of each target woody plant. Applications just prior to seasonal rainfall will give the most rapid response. Treatment effects on brush plants will be slow to appear and will not become apparent until later in the season. It has occurred to move the herbicide into the root zone of target brush plants. The time required to achieve control is dependent on soil type, amount of rainfall, and depth of species rooting. Some species may go through several deterioration cycles over a period of one to three years prior to dying.

TREATING INDIVIDUAL TREES

GRASLAN Brush Bullets are recommended for control of individual brush plants. Apply two GRASLAN Brush Bullets for each inch of trunk diameter per individual woody plant, but no more than 10 GRASLAN Brush Bullets tree regardless of tree size, distributed uniformly over the drip surface within the drip zone of each tree.

For more information, contact your local Extension Office or the manufacturer. Always read and follow the label directions for application. Apply GRASLAN Brush Bullets to the soil surface within the drip zone of each target woody plant.

PRECAUTIONS: Read the entire label before using GRASLAN Brush Bullets to determine if this product is suitable for the desired use.

GRASLAN Brush Bullets are intended for woody plant control. It is an extremely active herbicide which will kill trees, shrubs and other forms of desirable vegetation. Bullets extending into the treated area. Under roots of desirable trees may extend many feet beyond the drip canopy. A very small amount of GRASLAN Brush Bullets in contact with one feeder root of a tree, shrub or other desirable vegetation may cause serious injury or death to the entire plant.

Do not apply or reapply this product into any area into which the roots of desirable vegetation may extend. Do not apply in locations where the product may be washed by rain, sheet erosion, or moved by any other means into contact with roots of desirable vegetation, as severe injury or death may result.

GRASLAN Brush Bullets are not recommended for range sites which contain less than 200 trees per acre. The use of aerial broadcast application is recommended for areas with high brush, brush infestations.

Do not allow range grasses to grow from GRASLAN treated areas for two years after application.

Do not allow a fence boundary, animals to graze or consume hay harvested from areas treated with GRASLAN Brush Bullets for two years after application.

CAUTION

Keep out of reach of children. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Store away from foodstuffs and avoid contamination of any water supply.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL AND CARE

RESEAL CONTAINER AFTER EACH USE TO PREVENT ACCIDENTAL EXPOSURE OF PRODUCT TO PRECIPITATION SPILLAGE ETC. DO NOT REUSE EMPTY CONTAINER.

The herbicidal properties of GRASLAN require caution in handling, storage and transportation of this product. Do not contaminate water, food, feed, other pesticides, fertilizer or seeds. GRASLAN Brush Bullets that cannot be used according to label instructions should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies and desirable vegetation.
