The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes and submit one (1) copy to us before you ship your product:

1. Change "Statement of Practical Treatment" to "First Aid."
2. Revise your "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" section as follows:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store only in original container, in a dry place inaccessible to children and pets.

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Securely wrap in newspaper and discard in trash.

3. Move the following sentence, "NOTICE: California has determined that a chemical contained in this product causes cancer based on tests performed on laboratory animals", from its current location, under "STORAGE AND DISPOSAL" section, to the more appropriate "PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS" section, as a separate paragraph, under the "WARNING" heading, as follows:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

Causes eye, skin and respiratory tract irritation.
Harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

NOTICE: California has determined that a chemical contained in this product causes cancer based on tests performed on laboratory animals.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

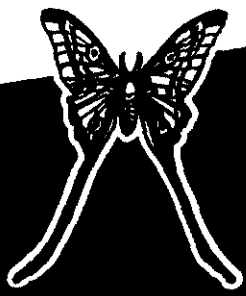

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Use one MOTH CAKE to every 12 cubic feet of lightly enclosed space. Place cake in plastic holder and hang in garment bag or over coat hanger. As chemical is used up replace with new unit.

Do not use in plastic storage box or place in contact with plastic items as paradichlorobenzene damages some plastics. Paradichlorobenzene should not be mixed or placed in contact with other moth preventive chemicals.
