 update your CSF dated May 31, 2002.

Label Approval The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under
 the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable with the
 following comments:

1. Delete the non-pesticidal claim "Deodorizes" from your labeling. We are concerned that some consumers may use your product only as a deodorizer and not as a pesticide. Furthermore, the claim conflicts with some of the directions for use that instruct the user "Do not.....allow vapors to escape into occupied rooms." The Agency has concerns with inhalation exposure for your active ingredient and we believe that the "deodorizes" claim may conflict with this concern. We will apply this policy to all paradichlorobenzene products.

2. In the future, please submit a master label with the official product name - ENOZ® Moth Cake - prominently on the front panel. This is the only label we will stamp. You may continue to submit the sublabels as you have been doing in the past. As a general policy we do not stamp sublabels; we only stamp the master label. There should only be one stamped/approved label for each product. Stamped sublabels are confusing because it implies the (stamped) sublabel is the official label for the product. This situation is particularly relevant in enforcement situations.

Existing Stocks Existing Stocks of previously approved labels may be used for 18 months.

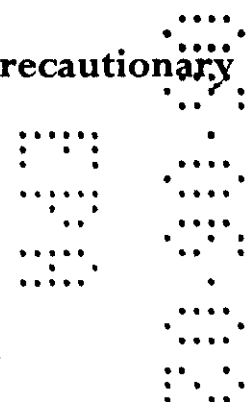
