We have received the above revised labeling and Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF), submitted under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended. The results of our review of these documents follow.

A. Revised Labeling. The labeling referred to above is acceptable provided that you make the following changes and submit one (1) copy to us before you ship product:

1. **Directions for Use:** Add as the first sentence to this section "It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling." To the 2nd sentence, replace "An insecticide for..." with "An insecticide *only* for..."
2. **Pesticide Disposal:** Correct "Environmental Control Agency, of the Hazardous Waster representative..." to Environmental Control Agency *or* the Hazardous Waste (delete r) representative..."
3. **Container Disposal:** Change "Then disposal of liner..." to "Then dispose of liner..."

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions. A stamped copy of the labeling is provided for your records.

B. Revised CSF. The agency has determined that the CSF dated May 14, 1998 is acceptable. A copy of this CSF has been placed in our file for this product. All previous versions are obsolete.
