Dear Ms. Tryson:

The amended label referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. This approval does not affect any conditions that were previously imposed on this registration. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.

A stamped copy of your labeling is enclosed for your records. This labeling supersedes all previously accepted labeling. You must submit one copy of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the new labeling. In accordance with 40 CFR 152.130(c), you may distribute or sell this product under the previously approved labeling for 18 months from the date of this letter. After 18 months, you may only distribute or sell this product if it bears this new revised labeling or subsequently approved labeling. "To distribute or sell" is defined under FIFRA section 2(gg) and its implementing regulation at 40 CFR 152.3.

Should you wish to add/retain a reference to the company's website on your label, then please be aware that the website becomes labeling under the Federal Insecticide Fungicide and Rodenticide Act and is subject to review by the Agency. If the website is false or misleading, the product would be misbranded and unlawful to sell or distribute under FIFRA section 12(a)(1)(E). 40 CFR

156.10(a)(5) list examples of statements EPA may consider false or misleading. In addition, regardless of whether a website is referenced on your product's label, claims made on the website may not substantially differ from those claims approved through the registration process. Therefore, should the Agency find or if it is brought to our attention that a website contains false or misleading statements or claims substantially differing from the EPA approved registration, the website will be referred to the EPA's Office of Enforcement and Compliance.

Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6. 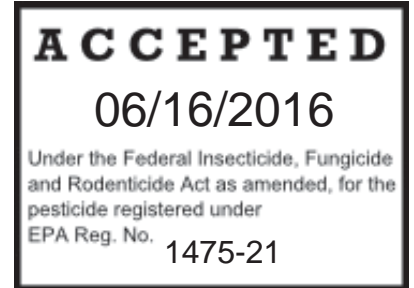

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Only for formulation into an *insecticide/repellent* for the following uses: For moth and carpet beetle control of human clothing and other household/domestic dwelling contents in air-tight containers (e.g. chests and trunks), garment bags and other storage containers and storage closets, and to repel lice and mites from bird cages.

It is the responsibility of the manufacturer of such products to develop specific directions for use that are appropriate and in compliance with applicable government regulations. If assistance is required, contact Willert Home Products or the Office of Pesticide Programs at U.S. EPA. This product may be used to formulate products for any additional uses not listed on the MP label if the formulator, user group, or grower has complied with U.S. EPA submission requirements regarding support of such uses.

Special packaging for mothball, flake, and crystal end use products are required to reduce the risk that children will ingest the product.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not exceed temperatures of 100° F (38° C). Avoid breathing dust or vapors. Use and store with adequate ventilation. Sweep up spilled material and place in original container for disposal.
