

FIRST AID: IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting. Drink promptly a large quantity of water. 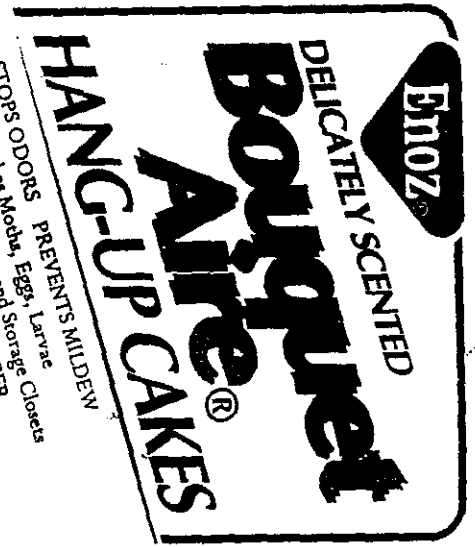

Use Restrictions: Kills clothes moths (larvae and adults) and carpet beetles in clean, air-tight containers (e.g., chests and trunks), and garment bags. Do not use in dry cleaning, garbage bags or containers that allow vapors to escape into occupied rooms. Do not use this product with any other moth control chemical. Do not allow product to contact printed, varnished or polished surfaces. If used in plastic containers, use only polyethylene or polypropylene containers.

Pre-Application Directions: Before storing, dry clean, wash or brush articles to be protected. Prevents moth infestation regardless of fabric type. Some articles containing vinyl's and polyurethane's may be damaged by exposure to this product. Examples, include raincoats, gloves and purses.

Application Directions: Unwrap each cake, and while holding them by their cellophane wrapper, transfer each back to the hang-up container. Apply product in clean, air-tight containers listed above at the rate of 5 ounces for 30 cubic feet of confined space. For a garment bag, multiply the length, width and height and divide by 5400* to determine the number of ounces of product needed. For example, a garment bag 54" long, 32" wide and 16" deep (i.e. 27,648 cubic inches) would need 5.1 ounces of product.
Post-Application Directions: Keep product in air-tight space for a minimum of seven (7) days. Odor dissipates when treated articles are aired.
Retreatment: Since moths are active all year, replenish air-tight containers and bags 2 times a year or when product has dissipated.



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
