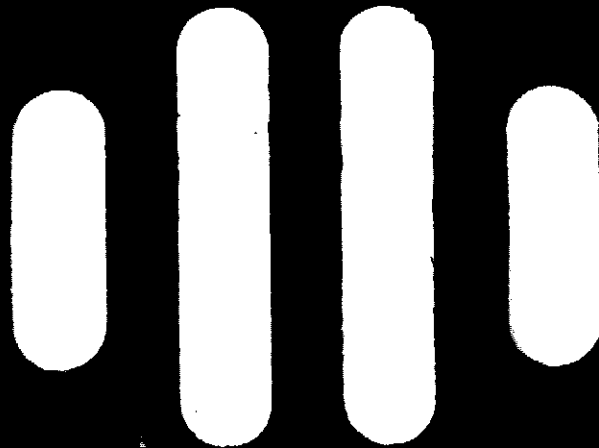

DIRECTIONS

1. Open flap at either side and remove cake from box. Take off protective cellophane wrap. Replace cake in box and close flap. Punch out all vent holes.
2. Hang or place box above garments or other articles to be protected.
3. Articles to be stored should be cleaned or thoroughly brushed before storing.
4. Use one cake to each 20 cubic feet of tightly enclosed space.
5. As cake is used up it must be replaced to maintain full protection.

PREVENTS MILDEW — Follow same directions as for moth preventive except use one cake to each 10 cubic feet of tightly enclosed space.

TO PROTECT TIGHTLY SEALED STORAGE AREA:

Carefully remove cake by opening this end flap. 
Remove cellophane. Replace cake. Close carton.

Thoroughly brush fabrics. Remove all grease and mildew spots. Hang or place carton in storage area above fabrics. Replace cake when SEALED area is occasionally opened. Use at least 1 cake for each 31 cubic feet.
