


DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

- Be sure articles are thoroughly brushed or cleaned.
- Use one cake for every 20 cubic feet of sightly enclosed space for moth protection; every 10 cu. ft. for mildew protection.
- Open flap, remove moth cake from box.
 Take off cellophane wrap... replace cake in box. Punch out all vent holes.
- Attach box at top of garment bag (or hanger) or to a wire, because vapors work downward.
- Check from time to time...replace with new Enoz Moth Cake when down to 1/3 of original size.
- Do not place in contact with plastic items as paradichlorobenzene damages some plastics.
- Do not use with any other moth preventive chemical.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS:

HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS. WARNING: Causes eye, skin and respiratory tract irritation. Harmful if Swallowed. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: IF SWALLOWED: Drink promptly a large quantity of water. Do not induce vomiting. Avoid alcohol. Get medical attention.
